

4. Please use **Chrome or Mozilla** to attend (Please avoid using Safari as there may be video/audio disturbance). There is a Hopin App for Apple users if you prefer to use that when accessing the event from your iPhone or iPad.

5. If your screen is loading at any point, don't hit the refresh or back button, this will make you drop off the system making you start over! Please **give the loading screen a chance**, first.
6. Please join **10-15 mins before** your designated speaking time through your speakers link. You will receive this via a separate calendar invite for your session.
7. Plenary speakers will join a virtual backstage and then be connected as group to the Plenary session. Parallel session speakers should join via '**Panels.**' (See screenshot).



8. The session will not end automatically when time is up, so please do **wrap up on time** (the schedule is quite packed).

10. When you return to the conference, this time not as a speaker, just login as you normally would to Hopin, and you will be free at this time to network or take a look around the expo.
